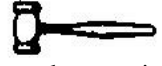

WHEREAS, California Masonic Code § 806.000 (A) states that a Lodge may authorize the Charity Committee to distribute a greater amount by a standing resolution; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Charity Committee of the above named Lodge shall have the authority to draw upon the Treasurer for any sum not exceeding \$500.00 at any one time for the relief of a distressed worthy Mason and the wife, widow, or orphan of a Master Mason.
