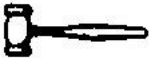



Don't miss this important event! Attend, and show your support for public schools.

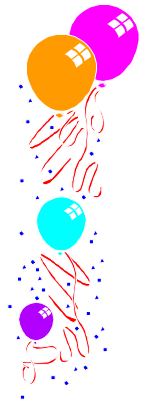
